Portugal's reputation for producing high quality and good value wines is ever-increasing, and we will taste an interesting mix of examples. We will taste four excellent ports, a white, a rosé, a 10-year-old tawny and a ruby (LBV) accompanied by a variety of chocolates. If you have never matched port with chocolate before this is a grand opportunity to give it a try and test your palate.

This should be an interesting and different tasting to warm us up for the new year.
